➤ A short list of the most important commands to know:

- C-h Enter the online help system
- C-xC-s Save the file
- C-xC-c Exit Emacs
- C-xu Undo last edit(can be repeated)
- C-g Get out of current command operation
- C-p Up by one line
- C-n Down by one line
- C-f Forward by one character
- C-b Back by one character
- C-v Forward by one screen
- C-s Search forward for characters
- C-r Search backward for characters
- C-d Delete current character
- Del Delete previous character
- C-k Delete from cursor to end-of-line
- C-y Restore what you've deleted

C- indicates the Ctrl key

➤ Some other useful Linux commands

- Who: Show who is logged into the system. With no options, list the names of users currently logged in, their terminal, the time they have been logged in, and the name of the host from which they have logged in.
- Echo: Send the input *string* to standard output.
- Logout: Log out of the system.
